Maasai Immersion, Tanzania

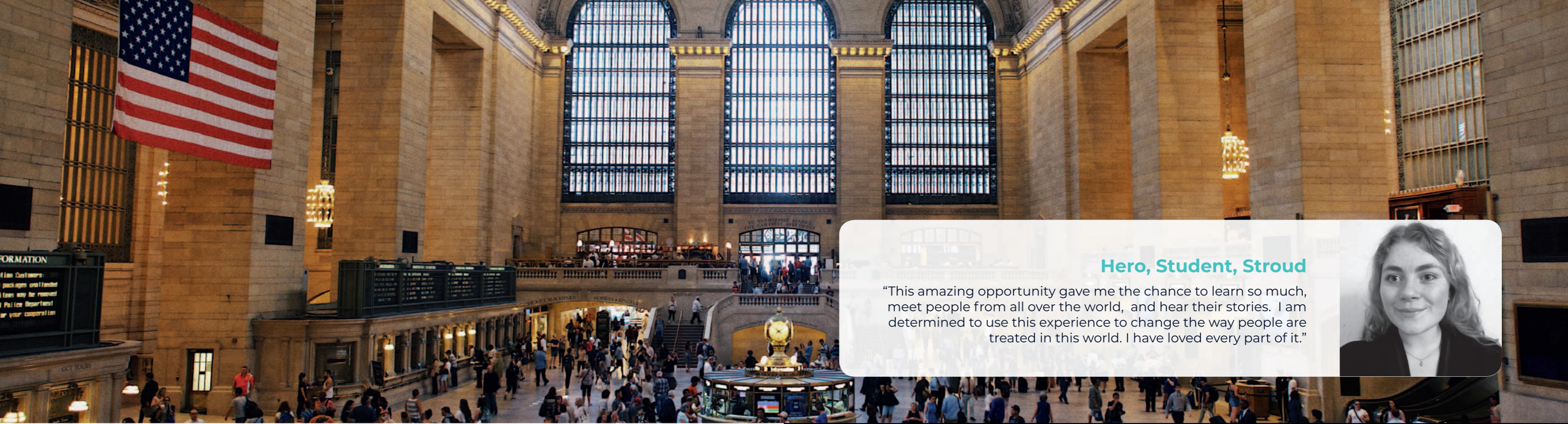

Opportunity 1: Human Rights Council

The Human Rights Council is an inter-governmental body within the United Nations system responsible for strengthening the promotion and protection of human rights around the globe and for addressing situations of human rights violations and make recommendations on them.



Opportunity 2: Universal Periodic Review

UPR is a unique process which involves a review of the human rights record of all UN Member States. It is part of the work of the Human Rights Council. This opportunity includes working with local CSOs and those interested in the countries under review.



Opportunity 3: CEDAW Sessions

CEDAW inspects the work for women and girls in the countries under review that year. Participants will have the opportunity to learn about a UN mechanism in depth and see how it is used in relation to the four countries under review in particular.

You will go on safari to World Heritage site Ngorongoro crater, Arusha National Park and spend a few nights in the paradise island of Zanzibar, snorkelling on the coral reef, visiting a spice farm, and swimming in the azure sea.

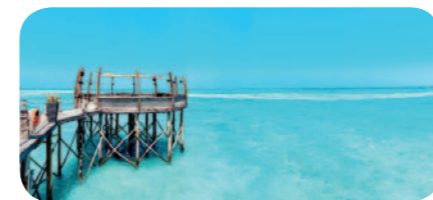

HIGHLIGHT 1: Social Action
Naserian, a local charity for widows, has positively changed the lives of thousands of women and children in ten villages in the Arusha district of Tanzania. You will be part of their on-going activities to improve the life of the whole community.



HIGHLIGHT 2: Safari
Ngorongoro Crater is on the wildlife migration route to Serengeti. After glamping, a dawn start will enable us to spend the day in the crater with a walk up a waterfall the following day. In Arusha National Park we will take driving and walking tours with an option for horse trails.



HIGHLIGHT 3: Zanzibar
Visiting a spice farm to see cinnamon, vanilla, pineapple etc growing wild; dinner at the farm; traditional boat ride with coral reef snorkeling in azure sea and sundowners on the way back; lounging on the fine white sands; visiting historic Stonetown...

The Programme



Experience Maasai village life

You will live in Lendikenya, a Maasai village, in traditional buildings and experience living the local life.

Get insight into a local charity

Make visits to several villages where Naserian is active. Meet widows and community leaders to learn about their challenges and achievements. Engage in service projects and reflect on learning every day with music by the fire in the evening.



Engage in service projects

Use your skills to help projects selected by Naserian widows. Projects have included building a widows centre, collecting stories, updating the website, designing jewellery, teaching children and more.

Make a presentation

Undertake your own activism and research to write your presentation. Get it reviewed and improved, with rehearsals in front of select audiences, and make the final presentation at one of the meetings with community leaders or the East African Community.



Go on safari

See major African mammals at the World Heritage Ngorongoro, and stay in igloos in a camp overlooking Manyara. Travel through banana plantations, and climb up a hidden waterfall. Go on another Safari at Arusha National Park, potentially with horse riding or canoeing.

Learn international policy

Learn about policy from people at the UN Residual Mechanism, (the legacy of the International Criminal Court for Rwanda), from high level representatives at the East African Community, and from community leaders in Arusha and the Maasai town of Monduli.

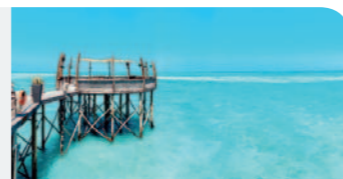

Working with Guild for Service, you will be informed by them of key issues facing women including widows in India. This will provide key insights into development work globally. You will meet academics, local women and activists and give a presentation.



HIGHLIGHT 2: CSO Experience
Participating in field visits and service projects you will see how policy is realised in action – the difference between words and deeds. Learning from women, girls and widows of all ages, you will experience something of their lived reality. And make a difference to their lives.



HIGHLIGHT 3: Tour of Kashmir
Visit the Dal Lake, surrounded by the Himalayas, sleep one night on the famous boat hotels and visit the floating market. Take local orphans on a picnic to the meadows. Work in the centre for conflict widows and hear their stories. Alternatively, you might visit the forest women and experience Jungle Book life.

Go on field visits

Visit Guild of Service initiated empowerment projects, interact with local colleges, students and rural women. Listen to presentations on women's issues. Enjoy yoga lessons and natural health cures.

Contribute to service projects

Work with local widows and the Guild to undertake service projects, contributing your unique skills to the projects. Whatever you have to offer, it will be used to help the widows and their children on projects they have requested support with.

Enjoy a cultural tour

Visit Delhi - Delhi Haat, Qutab Minar, Humayun's Tomb, Red Fort, India Gate and the Lotus Temple. See also Agra, Jaipur and Vrindavan - Taj Mahal, Agra Fort, Fatehpur Sikri, City Palace, Amber Fort.

Go on the Kashmir Tour

Stay in Srinagar, the Venice of the East. Stay overnight in a boat house and visit the floating vegetable market on Dal Lake. See the Mughal palaces and gardens. Work with orphan children of conflict and stay at a widow's centre.

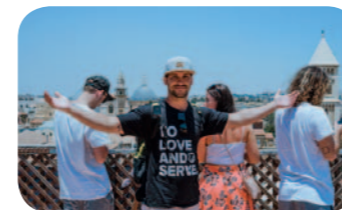

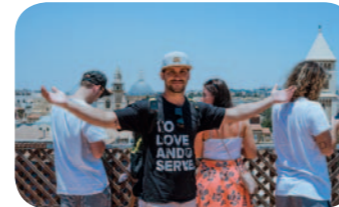
